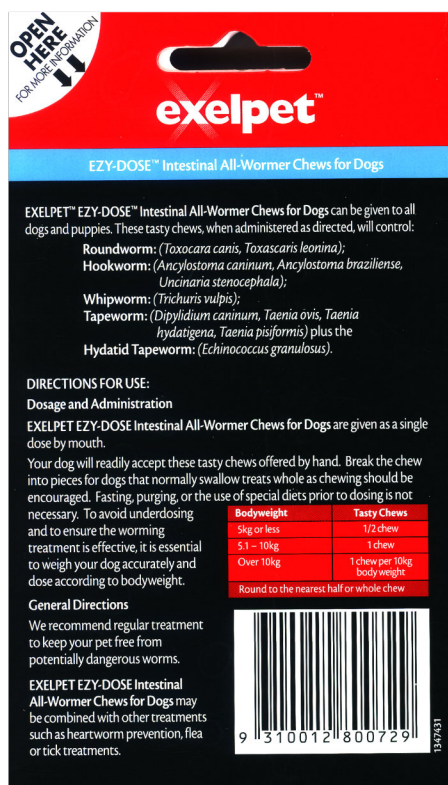

Treatment Frequency
Dogs can be reinfested with worms from other pets or from their surroundings, therefore treatment should be repeated regularly. Follow the treatment frequency recommendations in the following table and worm all your pets at the same time to maximise protection.

Puppies to 12 Weeks of Age	Puppies & Dogs From 12 Weeks of Age	Pregnant Bitches
Treat at 2, 4, 8 and 12 weeks for: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Roundworm• Hookworm	Treat every 6 weeks for: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Hydatid Tapeworm (Dogs should not be fed, or allowed to feed on, offal from any species).• Whipworm Treat every 3 months for: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Roundworm• Hookworm• Other Tapeworms	Treat at mating, before whelping and then every 3 months.

This treatment kills worms present in the gut, at the time of treatment. Immature hookworms in the migratory stage may not be affected. In specific cases where infestation is particularly heavy or many dogs are housed together more frequent treatment may be required. If worm problems persist, consult a veterinarian.

Important Information

1. To provide protection against heartworm use a heartworm prevention product, such as EXELPET™ EZY-DOSE™ Monthly Heartworm Treatment for Dogs.
2. Hydatid Tapeworms - dogs should not be fed, or allowed to feed on, offal from any species. Dogs in hydatid areas should be treated every 6 weeks.
3. Maintain a regular flea control program, as fleas are the intermediate host for the common flea tapeworm (*Dipylidium caninum*).
4. Always maintain a high standard of hygiene, including the daily collection and disposal of droppings.
